
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY June 2014

KEY FINDINGS


- Survey reveals 65% of organisations are planning to invest in new mobile technologies before 2017
- A quarter of respondents revealed that their organisation is planning a major investment in IT or mobile computing in the next 3 years. 40% indicated that a pilot project was being contemplated in the same time period
- The most significant investments a likely to be in the oil & gas, utilities and field service markets where mobile workers are most prevalent
- A staggering 82% of participants claimed that they were likely to pilot or invest in consumer grade mobile computing hardware including smartphones and tablets.






What vertical sector does your company operate in?



Does your organisation operate from multiple sites / centres?




How many additional sites does your organisation operate from?






What is your company's estimated annual turnover?






Does your organisation currently have mobile / field workers?




How many mobile / field workers are there in your organisation?



Does your organisation currently have a fleet of commercial vehicles?




How many vehicles are in your current fleet?







Are you currently using mobile computers in your business?



How many mobile computers do you own?




What operating systems do your mobile computers run on? (Tick all that apply)







What software applications are currently deployed on your mobile computers? (Tick all that apply)



Are you currently using smartphones in your business?




How many smartphones do you own?







What operating systems do your smartphones run on? (Tick all that apply)




Are you currently using tablets in your business?



How many tablets do you own?




What operating systems do your Tablets run on? (Tick all that apply)









Which of the following statements best describes your planned investment?



Which mobile computing device / form factor are you most likely to pilot / invest In? (Tick all that apply)




Has your organisation made any significant investments in any of the following areas over the last 3 years? (Tick all that apply)






Do you envisage any significant investments being made in your organisation in the following areas over the next 3 years? (Tick all that apply)







How will your company look to develop in mobile application software?



Which operating system are you most likely to develop mobile applications for?




What do you consider to be the main factor that drives the investment in mobile computing solutions within your organisation?






If applicable, are there any factors below preventing the wider adoption of mobile computing solutions within your organisation? (Tick all that apply)






Which, if any, of the following mobile computing 'sub technologies' & applications are likely to be of specific interest to your organisation over the next three years? (Tick all that apply)
